## Community Testing for Coronavirus (COVID-19)

Testing for members of the community that do not have symptoms (asymptomatic testing)

Last week the State Government announced it would be expanding COVID-19 testing throughout Victoria, to include people with no symptoms.

The purpose of the expansion is to provide authorities and healthcare professionals with an improved understanding of the spread of COVID-19 across the community.

The State has set an ambitious target to carry out 100,000 tests over the next fortnight, which will inform decision making affecting all Victorians in the coming weeks.

In response to this request CMH will provide drive through testing for people who wish to volunteer and meet the following criteria:

- Construction workers
- Retail and supermarket workers
- Agricultural workers
- Healthcare workers
- Emergency workers
- People with pre-existing chronic conditions
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait islanders

People without symptoms do not need to self-isolate after testing.

**This clinic is only for those people who have no symptoms and wish to volunteer for testing.**

(Symptoms may include, headache, loss of smell, fever, scratchy irritated throat, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, running nose, nausea, vomiting, muscles aches and pains).

There may be a waiting time dependant on the uptake of this service.
